Summary

This position is a combination of manufacturing and manufacturing support. This position will consult with other engineers, technicians, and management to discuss existing or potential projects and products. Contributions will include build, testing, verification, implementation, validation, maintenance and improvements of electronic instruments, equipment, facilities, components, products and systems. This person will apply electrical and/or electronic principles to both analog and digital systems to construct prototype and/or production assemblies (hands-on position). This person will support the analysis of failed product on the manufacturing line and provide support to quality for investigations and corrections.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Production Support:

- Ensure that Production and QA has automated assembly programs, reflow profiles, work instructions, etc. to maximize efficiency and minimize downtime.
- Perform Preventative Maintenance and repairs to key manufacturing equipment as assigned to minimize downtime.
- Train assemblers in the operation of various machines and processes.
- Work in production as required by management to ensure movement of product through the plant.

Process Engineering Support:

- Modify assembly programs and processes as required.
- Assist with evaluation and implementation of Engineering Change Orders.
- Help identify areas of improvement in processes.
